## American Airlines Announces Los Angeles As New Market For Boeing 777-300ER

Beginning June 1, 2013, American Airlines<sup>®</sup> service between London Heathrow and Los Angeles will feature the highly anticipated Boeing 777-300ER, giving customers an opportunity to enjoy the world-class travel experience this new aircraft offers.

American's 777-300ERs will be configured as three-class aircraft and will include fully lie-flat First and Business Class seats with direct aisle access, as well as Main Cabin. Main Cabin Extra seats providing additional legroom will be available in the front portion of the Main Cabin. Inflight entertainment at every seat, and Wi-Fi capability will keep customers connected while travelling internationally.

Customers travelling between Dallas/Fort Worth and Sao Paulo will be the first to experience the newest addition to American's fleet in December. In February 2013, the aircraft will fly from London Heathrow to both Dallas/Fort Worth and New York JFK.

The three-class cabin configuration in the new 777-300ERs will provide American with more customer and cargo capacity than any other aircraft in its fleet today. American will be the first airline to use a dramatic archway and ceiling treatment on the 777-300ER to create a feeling of spaciousness, and customers will be welcomed into the aircraft by unique mood lighting. A walk-up bar in the premium cabin stocked with snacks and refreshments will be a first for any U.S. airline and adds another unique element of luxury to the 777-300ER. Entertainment options include up to 120 movies, more than 150 TV programmes and more than 350 audio selections that will be offered throughout the aircraft.
